Beginning in January 2017, this comprehensive course will cover the basics of equine knowledge & horseback riding. The goal of the course is to provide a thorough & safe introduction to horses for those unfamiliar with them & to promote one of the most rewarding, confidence-building activities available to today's youth.

Each student will receive a course grade & certificate of graduation upon completion of course work & testing. Testing will include written, oral, hands-on application & riding exams.

Introductory Equine Studies, Level 1

- Two hour class session, meets 1x per week.
- Each session will feature 1 hour of class room time, 1 hour of hands-on-equine session.
- Weather permitting, hands-on-equine session will include 30 minutes of riding instruction.

Class room curriculum includes basic anatomy, color & markings, breeds, basic equipment, barn & equine safety, basic nutrition & history of the horse.

Riding Curriculum includes tacking & untacking, mounting, dismounting, proper form & balance, arena work at the walk & trot.

In-Barn, Hands-On Equine Curriculum includes grooming, bandaging, haltering & leading.

Class Size is limited to 6 students per session. Two sessions will be offered per week on Tuesdays & Thursdays at 10:00 a.m., beginning the week of January 16th. Student ages 8-18.
